MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

AUGUST - 1951

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 21,833 units in August, 1951 compared with 30,294 units in the previous month and with 24,272 units in August, 1950. The shipments for the current month included 13,840 passenger cars, 7,934 trucks and 59 buses.
