

## MCTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

## OCTOBER - 1952

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 41,659 units in October, 1952 compared with 41,063 units in the previous month and with 32,462 units in October, 1951. The shipments for the current month included 27,954 passenger cars, 13,680 trucks and 25 buses.
