## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

## MAY - 1952

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 42,690 units in May, 1952 compared with 46,908 units in the previous month and with 42,911 units in May, 1951. The shipments for the current month included 28,137 passenger cars, 14,525 trucks and 28 buses. The plant of the Ford Motor Company of Canada, Limited, was idle during the last two weeks of May because of the office-workers' strike.
