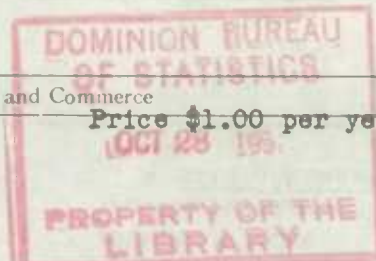

MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

JUNE - 1952



Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 41,910 units in June, 1952 compared with 42,690 units in the previous month and with 36,229 units in June, 1951. The shipments for the current month included 28,259 passenger cars, 12,804 trucks and 47 buses.
