## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPIGNTS

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 41,065 units in September, $15 j 2$ compared aith 22,853 units in the previous month and with 29,861 units in September, 1951. The shipments for the current month included 27,622 passenger cars, 13,400 trucks and 43 buses.
