## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

## SEPTEMBER - 1952

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 41,065 units in September, 1952 compared with 22,853 units in the previous month and with 29,861 units in September, 1951. The shipments for the current month included 27,622 passenger cars, 13,400 trucks and 43 buses.
