## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

## MARCH, 1953

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 51,990 units in March, 1953 compared with 42,904 units in the previous month and with 34,209 units in March, 1952. The shipments for the current month included 37,594 passenger cars, 14,387 trucks and 9 buses.
