## APRIL - 1953

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 52,420 units in April, 1953 compared with 51,990 units in the previous month and with 46,908 units in April, 1952. The shipments for the current month included 36,070 passenger cars, 16,341 trucks and 9 buses.
