## MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

July - 1953

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 48,691 units in July, 1953, compared with 49,900 units in the previous month and with 34,314 units in July, 1952. The shipments for the current month included 37,465 passenger cars, 11,219 trucks and 7 buses.
