Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalied 35,021 units in Soptember, 1953, compared with 22,640 units in the previous month and with 41,065 units in September, 1952. The shipments for the current month included 27,300 passenger cars, 7,660 trucks and 61 buses.
