MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 17,249 units in August, 1954, compared with 26,128 units in the previous month and with 22,640 units in August, 1953. The shipments for the current month included 14,533 passenger cars, 2,634 trucks and 82 buses.
