

MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 13,982 units in September, 1954. compared with 17,249 units in the previous month and with 35,021 units in September, 1953. The shipments for the current month included 10,548 passenger cars, 3,368 trucks and 66 buses.
