

AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

OCTOEER 1928

Production of automobiles in Canada during October totalled 18,536 cars. marking a further seasonal decline from the September output of 21,193 cars. and the August figure of 31,245 cars. In October of a year ago only 7,748 cars were made in Canada.

As compared with data for the previous month, the October production figures showed increases in the number of open model passenger cars to 3,765 from 3,506 and in chassis to 7,424 from 5,926 while the output of closed model passenger cars dropped to 6,717 from 10,836 and production of trucks declined to 630 from 925.

For the ten months ending October 31, 1928, the cumulative production of automobiles in Canada was 221,188 cars having a cales value, f.o.b plant, of \$139,909,876 as compared with 169,331 cars valued at \$110,736,126 made during the corresponding period of 1927. The increase this year amounted to 31 per cent in number and 26 per cent in value. Of the total number of cars made during the year 150,208 were made for sale in Canada and 70,980 were made for export.

Customs records show that the number of cars imported during October declined to 2,460 from 3,647 in the previous month, while exports increased to 9,755 from 8,706. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during October, as determined by adding the imports of 2,460 cars to the 7,190 cars made for sale in Canada, amounted to 9,650 cars. For the year to date the apparent consumption, thus computed, totalled 195,213 cars. Table 1.- Production of Automobiles in Canada, October 1927 and 1928.
