



## **AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA**

## MAY 1928

A new monthly record for automobile production in Canada was established in May when 33.942 cars were produced. This output was 40 per cent over the 24.211 cars made in April and 32 per cent greater than the previous high total of 25,708 cars recorded in May of last year. For each of the past four years the monthly output of cars has reached a peak in the month of May; in 1926 the May total amounted to 24,934 cars and in 1925 the corresponding total was 20,139 cars.

Advances over last month's output were general in all types of cars with the exception of a slight reduction in the number of chassis to 5,115 from 5,493. The principal gain was in closed passenger car models, production of which increased to 23,211 from 15,296; open passenger cars also advanced to 5.020 from 3,130; and trucks to 559 from 292 while 37 taxicabs or buses were made in May against none of this type in April.

Customs records show that 8,126 cars were imported into Canada during the month under review; this was an increase of 58 per cent over the imports of 5,150 cars in April. Export figures on the number of cars cleared from Canadian ports during the same period advanced 69 per cent to 6196 from 3,656.

A calculation of the number of cars made available for distribution in Canada during May, made by adding the imports of 8,126 cars to the 27,308 cars made for sale in Canada, gives a total of 35,434 cars. For the first five months of the year the number of cars made available in Canada, thus computed, totalled 96,327 cars.

For the five months ending May 31, 1928, the cumulative production of automobiles in Canada was 96,589 cars having a sales value, f.o.b. plant, of \$65,988,365. This output was 10 per cent less in number and 3 per cent lower in value than the figures for the corresponding period of a year ago. Conditions generally seem favourable to the industry, production having mounted steadily from the low for the year of 8,463 cars in January to the record output of 33,942 cars in May.
