AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

JULY 1928

Production of automobiles in Canada during July numbered 25,226 cars valued at \$14,399,432. This output was 11 per cent less in number and 16 per cent under the sales value of 28,399 cars worth \$17,115,893 made in June but was more than double the output in July last year of 10,987 cars valued at \$7,031,869. Compared with the previous month, July figures showed an increased production for all tipes of cars with the exception of closed models which dropped to 12,328 from 17,805. Open model passenger cars advanced to 5,531 from 5,450, trucks 856 from 781 and chassis to 6,511 from 4,363.

Customs records for June and July show that while fewer cars were imported into Canada during the latter month there was a corresponding increase in the number exported. In July imports amounted to 4,210 as against 6,315 in June and exports advanced to 8,057 from 5,653. For the first seven months of the year imports totalled 34,145 and exports, 34,808.

A calculation of the number of cars made available for distribution in Canada during July, made by adding the imports of 4,210 cars to the 15,897 made for sale in Canada, gives a total of 20,107 cars. For the year to date the number of cars made available in Canada, thus computed, totalled 143,862 cars.

For the seven months ending July 31, 1928, the cumulative production of automobiles in Canada was 150,214 cars having a sales value, f.o.b. plant, of \$97,503,690. Compared with 137,795 cars valued at \$87,975,776 made during the corresponding period of 1927 this year's output showed a gain of 9 per cent in number and 11 per cent in value. Of the total cars made during the year to date 109,717 were intended for sale in Canada and the balance of 40,497 were for export.
