

## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

## SEPTEMBER 1928

Production of automobiles in Canada during September amounted to 21,193 cars. This output was 33 per cent under the total of 31,245 for August but was almost double the number of 11,262 reported for September of a year ago. Production statistics for September, when compared with figures for the previous month, showed smaller outputs of all types of cars; open passenger cars dropped to 3,506 from 5,369, closed model passenger cars to 10,836 from 15,232 trucks to 925 from 1,280 and chase to 5,926 from 9,363. No taxicabs or buses were made in September as against 1 of this type in August.

For the nine months ending September 30, 1928, the cumulative production totalled 202,652 cars valued at \$129,328,879, a gain of 25 per cent in number and 23 per cent in value over the output of 161,583 cars worth \$105,179,954 during the first nine months of last year. This year's output to date included 33,020 open cars, 120,470 closed passenger cars, 5,266 trucks, 43,852 chassis, 35 taxicabs and 9 buses.

Customs records for September showed that imports of automobiles dropped to 3,647 from 4,753 and exports were lower at 8,706 as compared with the record for the year of 11,048 in August. For the first nine months of this year imports totalled 42,545 cars valued at \$36,435,206 and exports aggregated 54,562 cars appraised at \$23,752,638.

A calculation of the number of cars made available for distribution in Canada during September, made by adding the imports of 3,647 cars to the 13,360 cars made for sale in Canada, gives a total of 17,007 cars. For the three-quarter year period the number of cars made available in Canada, thus computed, totalled 185,563 cars.
