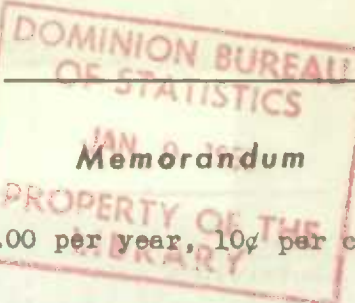

MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 28,860 units in November, 1955, compared with 26,299 units in the previous month and with 18,176 units in November, 1954. The shipments for the current month included 25,399 passenger cars, 3,450 trucks and 11 buses.
