MOTOR VEHICLE SHIPMENTS

Factory shipments of Canadian-made vehicles totalled 32,380 units in March, 1955, compared with 31,827 units in the previous month and with 45,634 units in March, 1954. The shipments for the current month included 26,744 passenger cars, 5,592 trucks and 44 buses.
