AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA
NOVEMBER 1929

November production of 9,424 motor vehicles in Canada was the lowest reported for ary month of the year to date, belne 35 per cent under the output of 14.523 cars in the provious month ard 20 par cent Iess than the total of 11,769 cars in November of a year ago. Th previous low for thia year was established in September at 13,817 care.

Compared with the figures for the next preceding month. data for Novemoer showed a fallirg off in the output of all typen of cars. Open passenger cars decilned to 1,565 from 1,693 ; closed model paseenger cars to 3,247 from 5,569: +شicks to 403 fiom 447 , ard chasel to 4,189 from 6,809. 5 taxicabs or buses were reported in October and this number was increased ia 20 in November.

Of the November total, 2,731 cars were made for eale in Canada and the balance of 6,693 were jnterded for export The apparent consumption of automobiles in Cansda during themonth, as determined by adding the 2,731 cars made for sale in Canada to the 1,259 cara jmparted, amounted to $3: 990$ cars. For the year to date ihm pparant consumption, thus computed, totalled 210,235 cars. Custome r-cords show that 1,259 cars were mported into Canada and 5,973 cars were were exparted during Ncvember to make total importa of 43,877 care and exporis of 97,392 cars for the first eleven months of this year.

For the eleven-month period endire November 30, 1929, the number of automobiles made in Canada totalled 257, 8C0 cars, a gin of 11 per cent over the $232,05 n$ cars produced during the corresponding month of last year. This year's output to date included 34,862 open passenger cars, 149,861 clased incdel passenger cara, 8,756 trucks, 64,156 chassis and 165 taxicabs or buses.
