## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

FEBRUARY 1929
Production of automobiles in Canada nubered 31,287 vehicles in February. This output was the highe日t reported for any February to date and was only exceeded in May of last year when tij monthly record was established at 33,942 cars. This month's production thowed a gain of 58 per cent over the output of 21,501 cars of the provious month and exceeded ky 172 per cent the +ntal of 12,504 cars produced in February of a year ago.

Data for Fobruary, when compared with the figures for January, Hhowed higher outputs of all types of cars. The principal gain was in closed model passenger cars which advanced to 18,661 units from 10,525 ; open passenger cars rose to 4,730 from 3,649 ; chassis to 6,969 from 6,750 and trucks to 927 from 577

Customs records for February show that 2,929 cars ware imported into Canada during the month and that a total of 10,856 car were exported during the same period Corresponding figures for January thowed an import of 1,780 cars and an export of 8,997 cars.

Of the total output during February, 21,016 cars were made for $8 a l e$ in Canada and 10,271 cars were intenced for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during the month, as determined by adding the 21,016 cars made for sale in Canada to the 2,929 cars imported, amounted to 23,945 cars. Comparative figures ahowing the number of cars available for consumption in Canada for the previous month totalled 13,285 cars and in Fobriaty last year, 11,726 cars.
