## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

## MARCH 1929

Production of utomobiles in Canada showed more than the customary seasonal increase during Narch, 1929, when the outpat reachod a new high record at 40,621 cars, acco:ding to data compiled by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at ottawa. This output was 20 per cent above the previous high level established last May at 33,942 cars and 30 per cent over the total of 21,287 cars made in February of this yoar, the third best month for the industry. The output of 40,621 cars during the current month was 64 per cent above the Bureau's moving average for the twelve months onding March, computed at 24,779 cars.

As compared with figures for February, the statistics for March showed increased outputs for all types of cars with the exception of open passenger cars which dropped to 4,107 from 4,730. Closed model passenger cars advanced 45 per cent in number to 27,145 from 18,661 ; trucks rose to 1,421 from 927 and the number of chassis increased to 7,948 from 6,969.

Customs records for March showed that 8,091 cars were imported into Canada during the month and that a total of 15,561 cars were exported durıng the same pericd For the firgt quarter of this year imports totalled 12,800 cars and exports aggregated 35,414 cars

Of the total output during March, 31,433 cars were made for sale in Canada and 9,188 cars were intended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during the manth, as determined by adding the 31,433 cars made for 8 ale in Canada to the 8,091 cars imported, amounted to 39,524 cars. For the firat three months of this year the number of cars made available for use in Canada totalled 76,754 cars as compared with a corresponding total of 38,214 care during the first quarter of last year, but in comparing the cumulative figures for these two years. it must be borne in mind that in the first part of 1928 on of the principal automobile manufacturere in Canada practically suspended operaticns pending a readjustment in plant and equipment due to the adoption of new models.
