# AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA 

## MAY 1929

According to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistice st Ottawa, the monthly figure on production of autcmobiles in Canada showed a decline during May for the first time this year, after reaching new high levels in March and again in April. Output in May dropped to 31,559 cars or 25 per cent below the record production of 41,901 care in the preceding month and 7 per cent less than the 33,942 cars reported for May of a year ago. The total for May was 21 per cent above the Bureau's moving average for the twelve months ending May, computed at 26,055 cars.

Compared with the figures for April, data for Nay showed that the output of open model passenger cars dropped to 3,162 from 5,761 , closed nodel passenger cars to 20.983 from 27,912, trucks to 1,012 from 1,422 , chasis to 6,376 from 6,787 while taxicabe or buses remained about the same at 21 as against 19 in April.

Customs' records for May showed that 8,281 care were imported during the month and 9,594 were exported. For the first five monthe of this year imports totalled 28,565 cars and exports aggregated 51,621 cars, an increase of 21 per cont in imports and 145 per cont in oxports over the 23,620 cars imported and 21,098 cars exported during the corresponding period of 1928.

Of the total output during May, 24,439 cars were made for sal in Canada and 7,120 cars were intended for exoort. The apparent coneumption of automobiles in Canada during the month, as dotermined by ading the 24,439 cars made for sale in Canada to the 8,281 cars imported, mounted to 32,720 care. For the five monthe ending May the number of care made available for use in Canada totalled 149,937 cars, an increase of 56 per cent as compared with a total of 96,327 cars during the first live months of last year.
