AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

JUNE 1929

A further pronounced seasonal decline in automobile production was reflected in the output figures for June when only 21,492 cars were made in Canada. May output at 31,559 cars marked the first recession from the rapid rise in output totals reported during each of the months from January to April, inclusive, that resulted in the establishment of a new monthly record in March which was in turn surpassed in April. The rise in production during the early months of the current year was more sharply marked than in any preceding year, and the seasonal recession, characteristic of the later months of the year, was begun this year a full month earlier than usual. Readjustment of the relations between production and markets will thus be brought about more quickly so that, while the output in succeeding months may be expected to follow a generally downward trend to the end of the year, it is probable that no further drastic reductions in output will be necessary and that the total for the year will be greater than in 1928.

Compared with the figures for the next preceding month, data for June showed declines in the output of closed passenger models, trucks and chassis while an increase was registered in the number of open passenger cars and taxicabs or buses. Closed passenger models dropped to 12,335 from 20,988, trucks to 914 from 1,012 and chassis to 4,832 from 6,376 while the number of open passenger cars rose slightly to 3,378 from 3,162 and taxicabs or buses to 33 from 21 in May.

Customs' records for June showed that 4,768 cars were imported into Canada during the month and that 8,270 were exported. For the first half of this year imports totalled 33,333 cars and exports numbered 59.891 cars, an advance of 11 per cent in imports and 124 per cent in exports over the figures for the corresponding period of 1928.

Of the June total 13,148 cars were made for sale in Canada and 8,344 cars were intended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during the month, as determined by adding the 13,148 cars made for sale in Canada to the 4,768 cars imported, amounted to 17,916 cars. For the six months ending June the number of cars made available for use in Canada totalled 167,853 cars, an increase of 36 per cent as compared with the corresponding total of 123,755 cars for the first half of 1928.

Production to date, this year, included 21,501 cars in January, 31,287 in February, 40,621 in March, 41,901 in April, 31,559 in May, and 21,492 in June, or a total of 188,361 cars.
