AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

JULY 1929

Production of automobiles in Canada during July amounted to 17,461 cars or 19 per cent under the total of 21,492 cars for the previous month and 31 per cent less than the output of 25,226 cars reported for July of a year ago. In July, 1927, production amounted to 10,987 cars and in July, 1926, to 15,208 cars.

Compared with the figures for the previous month the data for July showed a decline in number for each type of car made. Open passenger cars dropped to 2,766 from 3,378, closed model passenger cars to 9,270 from 12,335, trucks to 704 from 914, chassis to 4,701 from 4,832 and taxicabs or buses to 20 from 33.

Customs' records showed that 2,828 cars were imported into Canada and 7,378 cars were exported during July. For the first seven months of this year imports totalled 36,161 cars and exports numbered 67,269 cars, an increase of 6 per cent in imports and 93 per cent in exports over the corresponding figures for the seven months ending July 31, 1928, when 34,145 cars were brought into Canada and 34,808 were shipped to foreign countries.

Of the July output 9,529 cars were made for sale in Canada and 7,932 were intended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during the month, as determined by adding the 9,529 cars made for sale in Canada to the 2,828 cars imported, amounted to 12,357. For the seven months ending July, the number of new cars made available for use in Canada totalled 180,210 cars, an increase of 25 per cent over the total of 143,862 cars for the first seven months of last year.
