# AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA 

## AUGUST 1929

According to a statement issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottaw the production of automobiles in Canada during August was 14,214 cars. This cutput was the lowest reported for any month of the year to date, being 18 per cent under the total of 17,461 cars of the previous month and luss than one-half the output of 31,245 cars in August of last year.

Compared with the figures for the next preceding month the data for August showed that the decline was common to all typer uf cars made, with the exception of a slight increase in taxicabs or buses to 22 from 20. Open model passenger care dropped tu 1,824 from 2,766, closed model passenger cars dropped to 7,435 from 9,270, chassie to 4,544 from 4,701 and trucks to 389 from 704

Production for the eight months ending August of this year amounted to 220,036 care. This was the hignest output repoftwd for any eight-month period and exceeded by 21 ver cerit the total nf 181,459 cars produced during the corresponding porich of a year sgo. This year's output included 134,271 closed passenger care, 29,37? open passenger cars, 48.907 chassis, 7,366 trucks and 115 taxicabs or buses.

Of the August total 7,530 cars were made for sale in Canada and the balance of 6,684 were antended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada auring the month, as determined oy adding the 7,530 cars made for sale in Canada to the 2,411 care imported, amounted to $9,94 \mathrm{i}$ cars. For the year to dat. the apparent consumption, thus computed, totalled 190,151 cars Custome records show that 2,411 cars were 1 mported into Canada and 7,629 exported during August to make a total of 38,57 ? cars imported and 74,898 cars exported during the first aight months of this year.
