## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

OCTOBER 1930
Production of sutomobiles in Canada during October at 4,541 cars was the lowezt number reported for any month of the year to date. This output was 43 per cent under the total of 7,957 car.. reported for the previous month and less than one-third of the production of 14,523 cars in October of a yeur ago. The Buresu's monthly index number on motor car production, which makes due allowances for sessonal tendencies and is based on the long ter trend, 1919 to 1927 inclusive, chows that the October rate of output in the Canadian automobile induetry was 75 per cent below the normal for that monta.

Data for October, when combsed with that of the previoue month, showed lowered outputs for ill types of cars. Open passencer cars dropped to 822 from 1,289 , closed model passenger cars to 2,303 from 3,570 , truck to 315 from 509 , chtsais to 1,096 from 2,583 , and only 5 taxicabs or buce were made in October against 6 of this type in September.

For the ten month endins October 31, 1930, the cumulative production of atomobiles totsiled 143,163 car, a decline of 42 per cent from the aggregate of 248,376 cars made during the corresponding period of last year and 35 per cent lest than the 221,188 cars maae the first ten months of 1928.

A calculation of the number of cars made available for distribution in Canada durin October, made by addne the importe of 1,059 cars to the 2,662 cars made for sale in Canada, ives a total of 3,721 cars. For the year to date the number of cars ade avallable for Canadian con umption, thus computed, totalled 127,126 cars.
