## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

## NOVEMBER 1930

Production of automobiles in Canada during November totalled 5,40 cars. This output represented a gain of 19 per cent over the October total of 4,541 units but was 43 per cent below the corresponding figure of 9,424 cars for November of last year. This month's output included 3,527 passenger cars and 1,880 trucks; 2,574 units were made for sale in Canada and 2,833 were for export.

When compared with the figures for the previous month, the detail for November shows an increase in the production of chassis to 1,787 from 1,096 in Ociober, a gain in dassenger cars to 3,317 from 3,125 , and a decline in trucks to 299 frcm 315 . The number of taxicabs and buses was 4 as against 5 for last month.

For the eleven months ending November 30, 1930, the cumulative production of motor cars in Canada totalled 148,570 units, a decline of 42 per cent 8 rom the ageregate of 257,800 for the corresponding period of last year and 36 per cent below the output of 232,95 ? cars in the like pertod of 1928.

Import into Canada during Kovember numbered 682 cars. Exports were reported at 2,663 units.

By ading the imports of 682 cars in November to the 2,574 cars made for sale in Canada, a total of 3,256 units is obtained as representing the number of automobiles made available for distribution in Canada during that month. For the year to date the number of cars ma avallable for Canadian consumption, thus computed, totalled 130,382 cars.
