AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA
MARCH 1930

Production of automoblles in Canada during March numbered 20,730 cars. While ihis output was just about one-half the total of 40,621 cars made in the correeponaing month of last year, it was the higheat number reported for any month of the year to date, being almost double the output of 10.388 cars in January and 34 per cent greater than the 15,548 cars of February. The rate of prodiction in March was 669 cars per day, an increase of 114 cars a day over the daily average of 555 cars in February.

Data for March, when compared with the figures for Fobruary, shoved output eaine in all types of cars with the exception of taxicabs or buees which class dropped to 10 from 12 in February. Open paseonger cars advanced to 2,420 from 2,243; closed model passenger cars rose to 13,540 from 10,021 ; truck output reached 1,011 as against 539, and the number of chassis was increased to 3,749 in March from 2,733 in the preceding month. Of the March total, 83 per cent or 17.165 units were intended for passenger service and the balance of 17 per cent or 3,565 undta were for trucks.

Customs records showed that 3,805 cars were imported into Canada and 6,360 cars were exported during March. Corresponding figures for February indicated an import of 1,893 cars and an export of 4,280 cars.

Of the sotal output during March 16,244 cars were made for salo in Canada and 4,486 cars were intended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during the month, a detormined by adding the 16,244 cars made for sale In Canada to the 3,805 cara imported, amounted to 20.049 cars. For the first quarter of this year the apparent consumption, thus computed, amounted to 33,887 cars.
