# AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA 

JUNE 1930
Production of automobiles in Canada during June numbered 15,090 units. This was the lowest total reportad since the tutal of 10,388 cars for January last. The June output was 38 per cent under the record of 24,672 cart in May and 30 per cent less than the 21,492 cars made in June of last year. The Bureau's monthly index number on motor car production, which makes due allowance for seasonal tendencies and is based on the long term trend 1919 to 1927 inclusive, shows that output which was 4.7 per cent abuve normal in May declined to 30.6 per cent below nermal in June.

When compared with the data for May the figures for June show a lower output of passenger cars and chassis while a slight increase was registered in the number of trucks. The number of open passonger cars declined to 1,825 from 2,622. clcsed passenger cars to 9,213 from 17,480, chassis to 3,228 from 3,837, whil trucks advanced to 797 from 693 and taxicabs or buses to 40 from 27 of this type in May.

Customs' records show that the number of cars imported into Canade during June totalled 2,148 while exports amounted to $3,746$. Corresponding figures for May show import at 3,976 and exporte at 3,091.

Of the total cars produced in Canada during the month under review 4,296 were made for export and the balance of 10,794 were intended for sale in Canada. The apparent consumption of automobiles in Canada during the month, as cistermined by adding the 10,794 cars made for sale in Canada to the 2,148 cars imported, amounted to 12,942 cars to make a total consumption for the year to date of 103,009 cars.

For the six months ending June 30,1930 , the cumulative production totalled 110,685 , a decline of 41 per cent from the Bix monthe' record which was established in 1929 at 188,361 cars.
