## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

## AUGUST 1930

Production of automobiles in Canada during August, at 9,792 cars, showed little change from the 10,188 cars made in the previous month but was 31 per cent less than the total of 14,214 cars reported for August of a year ago. The Bureau's monthly index on motor car production, which makes due allowances for seasonal tendencies, and is based on the long term trend 1919 to 1927 inclusive, moved from the minimum for the year of 48.2 per cent below normal in July to a slightly higher level in August when it registered 46.8 per cent below the normal.

When compared with the figures for the previous month the statistics for August showed lower outputs for passenger cars and trucks while gains were marked up for open passenger cars and chassis. Closed model passenger cars dropped to 4,766 from 6,332 and trucks declined to 307 from 394 while open passenger cars advanced to 1,663 from 1,609 and the number of chassis rose to 3,036 from 1,833. During the month 20 taxicabs or buses were made, the same number as in July. For the eight months ending August the cumulative production of automobiles in Canada amounted to 130,665 cars, a decline of 41 per cent from the cutput of 220,036 cars in the corresponding period of last year and 28 per cent under the 181,459 cars made in the first eight months of 1928.

A calculation of the number of cars made available for distribution in Canada during August, made by adding the imports of 1,136 to the 5,225 cars made for sale in Canada, amounted to 6,361 cars. For the year to date the number of cars made available in Canada, thus computed, totalled 118,037 cars as compared with an available supply of 190,151 cars during the first eight months of 1929.
