# AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA 

## SEPTEMBER 1930

Production of automobiles in Canada during September awounted to 7,957 cars, the lowest number reported for any month of the year to date. This output was 19 per cent under the total of 9,792 for the previous month and 42 per cent less than the 13,817 cars made in September of 2 year ago. The Bureau' mon hly index number on motor cer production, Which makes due allowances for seasonal tendencies and is based on the long term trend 1919 to 1927 inclusive, shows that the September rate of output in the Canadian \&utomobilo induetry was 58.9 per cent below the normal for that month.

Data for Septerber, when compared with the statistice for the previous month, showed swaller outputs for all types of cars with the excoption of trucks which advanced slichtly to 509 units from 307 in August. Open paseenger cara declined to 1,289 from 1,663 , closed model pessenger car dropped to 3.570 from 4,786 , chaseis receded to 2.583 from 3,036 , and the number of taxicabs or buses was lower at 6 asainst 20 of this type in the previous month.

For the first nino months of this year the cumulative production of cars totalled 138,622, a deciine of 41 per cent from the nine-month record established in the previous year at 233,853 cars which in turn wes 13 per cont greater in number than the total of 202,652 cars made during the first three-quarters of 1928.

This year's output to date was proportioned as followe: closed model passenger cars, 64 per cont; chassis, 20 per cent; oden passonger cars, 12 per cent, and trucks, almost 4 per cent. The number of taxicabs and buses was under 1 per cent.

A calculation of the number of cars made available for diairibution in Canada durirg September, made by adding the imports of 1,458 to the 3,910 cars made for sale in Canada, gives a total of 5,368 cars. For the year tu date the number of cars made available for Canadian consumption, thus computed, totalled 123,406 cars.
