

AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

OCTOBER 1931

Production of automobiles in Canada during October totalled 1,440 cars. When compared with the figures for September, this output showed a falling-off in the number of passenger cars to 761 from 2,108 while trucks advanced to 679 from 538. In October of a year ago output was reported at 4,541 cars.

Customs' records for the month under review showed that 150 cars were imported into Canada and that 712 cars were exported during the period. Figures for the first ten months of this year showed total imports at 8,604 cars and exports at 13,756 cars as compared with imports of 21,673 cars and exports of 38,990 cars during the corresponding period of last year.

Of the total output during October, 743 cars were made for sale in Canada and the balance of 697 were intended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles during the month as determined by adding the 743 cars made for sale in Canada to the 150 cars imported, amounted to 893 cars. The number of new cars made available for use in this country during the ten months ending October 31, 1931, totalled 75,682 cars as compared with 127,126 cars in the first ten months of 1930.
