## AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

## NOVEMBER 1931

Production of motor vehicles in Canada during November numbered 1,247 units. When compared with the figures of the preceding month this output showed a slight advance in the number of passenger cars to 812 from 761 , but this gain was more than offset by a drop in the number of trucks to 435 from 679. In November, 1930, a total of 5,407 cars were produced.

Customs' records for the month under revjew showed that 84 cars were imported into Canada and that 480 cars were exported during the pericd. Figures for the first eleven monthe of this year showed total imports at 8,688 cars and exports at 24,236 cars as compared with imports of $22,355 \mathrm{cars}$ and exporta of 41,653 cars during the corresponding period of last year.

Of the total output during November, 886 cars were made for sale in Canada and the balance of 361 were intended for export. The apparent consumption of automobiles during the month as determined by adding the 886 cars made for $8 a l e$ in Canada to the 84 cars imported, amounted to 970 cars. The number of new cars made available for use in this country during the eleven monthe ending November 30, 1931, totalled 76,652 cars as compared with 130,382 cars in the first eleven months of 1930.
