# AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA 

## APRIL 1931

Production of automobiles in Canada during April amounted to 17,159 cars, an average of 572 cars per day as compared with a daily output of 419 cars in March and 809 cars in April of a year ago. The rate of output in April of this year was 37 per cent higher than in March and the improvement over the preceding month was the greatest for any month of the year to date. Comparison of this month's figures with those for March shows that the increase was mostly in closed passenger cars with smaller gains for all other models. Closed passenger cars advanced to 12,336 from 9,319 open passenger cars to 1,655 from 1,002 and trucks also rose to 3,116 from 2,510.

The Bureau's index number of motor car production, which is adjusted for seasonal variation and expressed as a percentage of the long term trend determined from the period 1919 to 1928 inclusive, which started in January at 60 per cent below the normal, moved up 20 points during the first quarter of this year and again advanced 14 points in April to register 26 per cent below the normal.

Customs records for April showed that 1,421 cars were imported into Canada and that l,209 cars were exported during the month. Figures for the first four months of this year showed total imports at 5,221 cars and exports at 7,798 cars as compared with imports of 10,420 cars and exports of 16,958 cars during the corresponding psriod of last year.

Of the total output during April, 15,837 cars were made for sale in Canada and the balance of 1,322 were intended for expnrt. The apparent consumption of automobiles during the month, determined by adding the 15,837 cars made for sale in Canada to the 1,421 care imported, amounted to 17,258 cars. The number of new cars made available for use in this country during the four months ending April 30, 1931, totalled 44,709 cars as compared with 64,612 cars in the first four months of last year.
