

AUTOMOBILE STATISTICS FOR CANADA

SEPTEMBER, 1932.

Production of motor vehicles in Canada during September numbered 2,342 units as compared with 4,067 in the previous month and 2,646 in the corresponding month of a year ago. Compared by types of cars the September figures show that output of open passenger cars dropped to 212 from 877, closed model passenger cars to 1,200 from 2,271 and trucks to 601 from 901 in August.

Customs' records show that the number of cars imported into Canada during September dropped to 56 from 86, while during the same period exports advanced to 1,717 from 1,566. The export figure for September was the highest for any month of this year to date.

of this month's output 1,081 cars were made for sale in Canada, leaving a balance of 1,261 cars intended for export. The apparent consumption of cars during the month as determined by adding the 1,081 cars made for sale in Canada to the 56 imported, amounted to 1,137 cars. During the next preceding month the apparent consumption, thus computed, was 2,398 cars and in September, 1931, it totalled 2,299 cars.
