



Annual Industry ReportIron and Steel and Their Products GroupTHE FARM IMPLEMENTS AND MACHINERY INDUSTRY, 1947

Production by establishments in the farm implements and farm machinery industry was 41.4 per cent higher in value in 1947 than in 1946, and 55.2 per cent higher than in 1945. Actual values (at factory prices) for these years were as follows: \$89,423,469 in 1947, \$63,238,542 in 1946 and \$57,621,390 in 1945. The output of farm equipment, in this industry amounted to \$79,966,899 in 1947, \$52,247,004 in 1946 and \$37,751,375 in 1945; the remainder of the output of the industry in each year was made up of industrial machinery, dairy equipment, etc. In other industries there was a small production of farm machinery amounting to \$3,963,218 in 1947, \$1,743,846 in 1946 and \$949,000 in 1945.

Sixty-one factories were included in the farm implements industry in 1947, there being 37 works in Ontario, 6 in Quebec, 7 in Manitoba, 6 in Alberta, 3 in Saskatchewan, 1 in Prince Edward Island, and 1 in British Columbia. The works in Ontario accounted for 95 per cent of the total output.

The industry employed an average of 16,013 workers during the year, the 2,325 salaried employees being paid \$5,261,562 and the 13,688 wage-earners \$25,982,444. The total of \$31,244,006 for salaries and wages was 22.6 per cent more than the amount distributed to the 13,866 employees in 1946.
