

THE AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS INDUSTRY

1949

Production by establishments in the agricultural implements industry was 20.4 per cent higher in value in 1949 than in 1948, and 98 per cent higher than in 1947. Actual values (at factory prices) for these years were as follows: \$176,970,283 in 1949, \$146,956,254 in 1948, and \$89,423,469 in 1947. The output of farm equipment, in this industry amounted to \$164,794,099 in 1949, \$132,496,881 in 1948 and \$79,966,899 in 1947; the remainder of the output of the industry in each year was made up of miscellaneous types of machinery and parts. In other industries there was a small production of farm machinery amounting to \$4,823,000 in 1949, \$6,582,000 in 1948 and \$3,963,000 in 1947.

Seventy-nine factories were included in the agricultural implements industry in 1949, there being 39 works in Ontario, 15 in Manitoba, 10 in Alberta, 6 in Quebec, 6 in Saskatchewan, 2 in British Columbia and 1 in Prince Edward Island. The works in Ontario accounted for 96 per cent of the total output.

The industry employed an average of 17,074 workers during the year, the 3,214 salaried employees being paid \$9,481,186 and the 13,860 wage-earners \$34,738,403. The total of \$44,219,589 for salaries and wages was 2.3 per cent less than the amount distributed to the 18,747 employees in 1948.
