

THE AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS INDUSTRY, 1951

Production by establishments in the agricultural implements industry was 14.5 per cent higher in value in 1951 than in 1950, but 3.3 per cent lower than the record high reported in 1949. Actual values (at factory prices) for these years were as follows: \$171,172,496 in 1951, \$149,500,240 in 1950, and \$176,970,283 in 1949. The output of farm equipment in this industry amounted to \$158,779,197 in 1951, \$137,971,548 in 1950, and \$164,794,099 in 1949; the remainder of the output of the industry in each year was made up of miscellaneous types of machinery and parts. In other industries there was a small production of farm machinery amounting to \$3,570,000 in 1951, \$3,702,000 in 1950, and \$4,823,000 in 1949.

Eighty-one factories were included in the agricultural implements industry in 1951, there being 35 works in Ontario, 16 in Manitoba, 11 in Alberta, 9 in Saskatchewan, 6 in Quebec, 3 in British Columbia and 1 in Prince Edward Island. The works in Ontario accounted for 94 per cent of the total output.

The industry employed a total of 17,353 workers during the year, the 3,275 salaried employees being paid \$10,727,332 and the 14,078 wage-earners, \$41,490,098. The total of \$52,217,430 for salaries and wages was 20.6 per cent more than the amount distributed to the 16,223 employees in 1950.
