

THE AGRICULTURAL IMPLEMENTS INDUSTRY

1952

Factory shipments reported by establishments in the Agricultural Implements Industry were valued at \$205,775,487 in 1952. The output of farm equipment in this industry amounted to \$188,183,920 in 1952, \$158,779,197 in 1951 and \$137,971,548 in 1950; the remainder of the output of the industry in each year was made up of miscellaneous types of machinery and parts. In other industries there was a small production of farm machinery amounting to \$6,504,000 in 1952, \$3,570,000 in 1951 and \$3,702,000 in 1950.

Note: Data presented in this bulletin for 1952 under the heading of "Production" actually represent "Factory Shipments" and, therefore, are not exactly comparable with previous years.

Eighty-five factories were included in the Agricultural Implements Industry in 1952, there being 35 works in Ontario, 18 in Manitoba, 12 in Alberta, 10 in Saskatchewan, 6 in Quebec, 3 in British Columbia and 1 in Prince Edward Island. The works in Ontario accounted for 94 per cent of the total output.

The industry employed a total of 18,046 workers during the year, the 3,293 salaried employees being paid \$12,720,196 and the 14,753 wage-earners, \$49,703,520. The total of \$62,423,716 for salaries and wages was 19.5 per cent more than the amount distributed to the 17,236 employees in 1951.
