## THE BICYCLE INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1927.

According to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa, production from the bicycle industry in Canada was valued at \$1,194,471 in 1927 as against \$1,453,658 in the previous year and \$1,445,901 reported for 1925. One concern went out of business during the year while another engaged chiefly in making children's vehicles has been transferred to a different industry, leaving only 3 firms in this group for 1927; all were located in Ontario and the total output was slightly over the corresponding figure for the same 3 establishments in 1926. These concerns employed a capital of \$2,254,813, afforded employment to an average of 408 people to whom \$420,990 was paid in salaries and wages, and by mamufacturing processes added \$583.347 to the value of purchased materials which cost \$611,124. Among the products were 22,586 men's bicycles valued at \$577,691 and such other articles as bicycles for women and children, tricycles for children, bicycle parts and skates.
