THE BICYCLE INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1929.

Production from the bicycle industry in Canada during 1929 reached a new high value of (2,470,383, according to a strengt published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. This output was 12 per cent over the previous record established in 1928 at \$2,213,493 and was 107 per cent over the corresponding figure for 1927.

Only 3 firms manufactured bicycles in Canada during 1929; all were located in Ontario. These concerns employed a working capital of \$2,534,749, afforded employment to an average of 590 people to whom \$737,410 was paid in salaries and wages, and by manufacturing processes added \$1,350,164 to the value of purchased materials which cost \$1,132,219. Among the products of this industry were included 33,482 bicycles valued at \$899,480 and such other articles as tricycles for children, bicycle parts and skates.
