TIIE BICICIE INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1830.
Production from the bicycle industry in Conada during 1930 reached a value of H1,902,947, ascording to a statement published by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. This output was 21 por cent under the record establisied in the previous year at $\mathbf{5} 2,470,383$, and was 11 per cent less than the correspondine figure for 1922 .

Only 3 firms manufactured bicycles in Canada during the year and all wore located in ontario. These concerns employed a working capital of $\$ 2,931,867$, afforded employment to an average of 495 people to whom $\$ 595,6 \leq 1$ was paid in sularies and vages, and by manureturing processes aided \$578,081 to the value of purchased materials which cost 1 1, 384,866 . Among the products of this industry were included 26,26 bjeycles valued at $\$ 706,386$ and suci ather articles as tricycles for children, bicjcle parts and skates.
