IRON AND STEEL AND THEIR PRODUCTS

THE BICYCLE MANUFACTURING INDUSTY, 1934.

Manufacturers of bicycles in Canada reported a total output valued at \$1,033, 422 in 1934 as compared with \$712,624 in 1933. Products included 32,647 bicycles worth \$651,620 at factory prices, tricycles and other children's vehicles and ice skates.

Bicycle concerns employed a capital of \$2,330,478 of which \$1,118,613 represented the value placed on plants and factory equipment. An average of 263 workers were employed throughout the year and \$333,667 was expended for salaries and wages. Fuel and power cost \$30,166 and \$503,748 was paid for manufacturing materials.
