 THE MACHZ NERY INDUSTRY IN CAIADA, 1927.

Isoluction from the machinery industry in Canada during 1927 was valued at $\$ 44,602,135$, an increase of 16 per cent over the output value of $\$ 38,380,019$ in 1926 . and 10 per cent over the previous record of $\$ 40,535,474$ established in 1920 .

Of the 160 firms reporting to the Bureau of Statistics, under the machinery 1nduatry, 116 were located in the province of Ontario. 27 in Quebec, 10 in British Columbia, 4 in Manitoba, 2 in Saskatchewan, and 1 in New Brunswick. These concerns employed a capital of $\$ 62,006,808$, gave work to an average of 9.947 people to whom the sum of $\$ 13.094,050$ was paid in salaries and wages, used fuel and electricity morth $\$ 710,033$, and by manufacturing processes added $\$ 29,324,162$ to the value of purchased materials which cost $\$ 15.277 .973$.

Among the main products of the industry were the following items: pulp and paper machinery valued at $\$ 8,432,332$; household machinery at $\$ 5,043,375$; office and business machinery, $\$ 5,090,501$; mining and metallurgical machinery, $\$ 2.406,077$; elevators and parts, $\$ 2,608,307$; water wheels and turbines, $\$ 1,384,485$; metal working machinery, \$1,362,977; laundry machinery, \$1,345,537; pumps, \$1,102,303; transmission machinery, $\$ 1,118,447$ i and other lines such as fire fighting apparatus, oil burners, pipe and fittings, automobile accessories, conveyors, and machinery for bottling, refrigerating, flour mills, grist mills, bakeries, woodworking, stoneworking, etc.
