Froduction from the machinery industry in Canada during 1959 reached a new high value or \$65,692,539, according to the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. This value was 29 per cent Greater than the previous record of \$51,046,140 attained in 1928 and was 47 per cent above the total of \$44,602,135 in 1927, the third best year.

This industry includes only those firms which manufactured machinery as their main product and in 1929 covered the operations of 169 establishments distributed by provinces as follows: Ontario, 120; Quebec, 28; British Columbia, 8; Manitoba, 7; Saskatchewan, 4; New Brunswick, 1; and Alberta, 1. The average number of persons employed during the year was 12,435 and disbursements for salaries and wages amounted to \$17,091,918. The total capital employed was reported at \$75,220,204.
