IRON AND STEEL AND THEIR PRODUCTS.

THE MACHINERY INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1930.

Production from the machinery industry in Canada during 1930 amounted in value to \$53,749,482. The record of \$65,692,539 for this industry was attained in the previous year while output for other years was reported at \$51,046,140 in 1928, \$44,602,135 in 1927 and \$38,380,019 in 1926.

This industry includes those factories in which industrial, household or office machinery were the main products made. In 1930 a total of 174 establishments were classed in this group; 122 were located in Ontario, 27 in Quebec, 10 in British Columbia, 9 in Manitoba, 4 in Saskatchewan, and 2 in Alberta. The average number of persons working in these plants during the year was 11,044 and payments for salaries and wages amounted to \$15,089,837. Purchased materials cost \$18,326,621 at the factory and the value added by manufacturing processes was \$35,422,861.

Among the principal products made by these firms were: 63,647 electric washing machines at \$8,556,095; freight and passenger elevators with parts at \$5,069,753; pulp and paper machinery at \$5,014,420; transmission machinery at \$1,280,281; 11,183 scales of all kinds at \$1,246,693; hoisting machinery at \$1,239,821; pumps (other than gasoline handling) at \$1,172,083, and many other lines such as gasoline handling pumps, air compressors, sewing machines, cash registers, fire extinguishing equipment, laundry machinery, adding machines, conveyors, grain elevator machinery, gasoline service station equipment, and other articles of a similar nature.
