# THE MACHINERY INDUSTRY, 1945

The annual census of production in Canada divides manufacturing into nine main groups of industries to which the producing concerns are classified according to the principal materials used. For example, the pulp and paper industry is classified under "Wood and Paper Products", iron foundries under "Iron and Steel and Their Products", etc. These main groups are further divided into industries to which the concerns are allotted according to the nature of their main products. The iron and steel group is subdivided into 17 industries, one being the Machinery Industry, which is reviewed in this bulletin. This industry covers the operations of iron and steel works which were occupied chiefly in making industrial, household, office and business machinery. Farm implements and machinery and electrical machinery and supplies are covered by separate reports.

Some concerns in other industrial groups made machinery as secondary or minor products so the production figures for the Machinery Industry do not necessarily represent the total Canadian output of the commodities listed. Table 11 of this report summarizes the total machinery production as assembled from all industries; in 1943 the total for industrial, office, business and household machinery (including electrical machinery was \$159,095,805, compared with \$163,438,107 in the previous year.

During the year under review, there were 256 factories in Canada which normally manufactured industrial, household, office and business machinery (exclusive of electrical or agricultural machinery) as their principal products. These plants were classified to the Machinery Industry and their output in 1943 was valued at \$152,359,576, a decline of 4.4 per cent from the corresponding total of \$159,371,788 for 1942.

Of the 256 establishments operating in this industry, 170 were located in Ontario, 44 in Quebec, 24 in British Columbia, 8 in Manitoba, 4 in Saskatchewan, 3 in Nova Scotia and 2 in Alberta and 1 in New Brunswick. Ontario firms accounted for 62 per cent of the total production for the Dominion, Quebec 28 per cent, and concerns in British Columbia, 8 per cent. These producers of machinery had a capital investment in Canada of \$123,621,515 and afforded employment to a monthly average of 28,239 people who received \$52,818,044 in salaries and wages. Expenditures for fuel and electricity amounted to \$1,799,257 and materials used in manufacturing processes cost \$48,685,844.

Products made in this industry included washing machines and ironers, cash registers, sewing machines, typewriters, transmission machinery, pulp and paper machinery, elevators, air compressors, rock drills and mining machinery, road-making machinery, gasoline-dispensing pumps, machine tools, rolling mill machinery, etc. Detailed production data for the industry are given in Table 10 and supplementary figures to show the total output of machinery from all industries in Table 11.
