

THE MACHINERY INDUSTRY - 1947

The annual census of production in Canada divides manufacturing into nine main groups of industries to which the producing concerns are classified according to the principal materials used. For example, the pulp and paper industry is classified under "Wood and Paper Products", iron foundries under "Iron and Steel and Their Products", etc. These main groups are further divided into industries to which the concerns are allotted according to the nature of their main products. The iron and steel group is subdivided into 17 industries, one being the Machinery Industry, which is reviewed in this bulletin. This industry covers the operations of iron and steel works which were occupied chiefly in making industrial, household, office and business machinery. Farm implements and machinery and electrical machinery and supplies are covered by separate reports.

Some concerns in other industrial groups made machinery as secondary or minor products so the production figures for the Machinery Industry do not necessarily represent the total Canadian output of the commodities listed. Table 9 of this report summarizes the total machinery production as assembled from all industries; in 1947 the total for industrial, office, business and household machinery (including electrical machinery) was \$276,382,300 compared with \$185,804,093 in the previous year.

During the year under review, there were 322 factories in Canada which normally manufactured industrial, household, office and business machinery (exclusive of electrical or agricultural machinery) as their principal products. These plants were calssified to the Machinery Industry and their output in 1947 was valued at \$200,894,754 an increase of 37.9 per cent from the corresponding total of \$145,638,248 for 1946.

Of the 322 establishments operating in this industry, 202 were located in Ontario, 56 in Quebec, 38 in British Columbia, 14 in Manitoba, 4 in Saskatchewan, 3 in Nova Scotia, 3 in Alberta and 2 in New Brunswick. Ontario firms accounted for 65.0 per cent of the total production for the Dominion, Quebec, 26.5 per cent, and concerns in British Columbia, 6.0 per cent. These producers of machinery afforded employment to a monthly average of 29,920 people who received \$61,969,692 in salaries and wages. Expenditures of fuel and electricity amounted to \$2,216,382 and materials used in manufacturing processes cost \$74,101,757.

Products made in this industry included washing machines and ironers, cash registers, sewing machines, typewriters, transmission machinery, pulp and paper machinery, elevators, air compressors, rock drills and mining machinery, road-making machinery, gasoline-dispensing pumps, machine tools, rolling mill machinery, etc. Detailed production data for the industry are given in Table 8 and supplementary figures to show the total output of machinery from all industries in Table 9.
