THE AUTOMOBILE PARTS AND ACCESSORIES INDUSTRY IN CANADA, 1927.

A bulletin issued by the Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa states that production from the automobile parts and accessories industry in Canada during 1927 was valued at \$14,862,616, an increase of 7 per cent over the \$13,914,965 reported for the previous year which in turn was 15 per cent better than 1925.

Of the 78 plants reporting in this industry, 46 were located in Ontario, 12 in British Columbia, 7 in Quebec, 6 in Alberta, 6 in Manitoba and 1 in Saskatchewan. These concerns represented a capital investment in Canada of \$13,065,269, employed a monthly average of 2,966 people who received \$3,846,185 in salaries and wages, and by manufacturing processes added \$7,174,804 to the value of purchased materials which cost \$7,687,812.

Articles made in this industry included automobile wheels, springs, bodies, tops, bumpers, radiators, tire rims, covers for tires, seats and radiators, windshields, carriage parts, motometers, bearings, motor parts, shock absorbers, trailers and many other parts and accessories for the automobile trade.

The group reviewed in this bulletin includes only those plants in Canada which manufacture parts or accessories as their principal product. Many other establis 173 produce commodities for use in the automobile trade but their main business is of such a nature as to necessitate their classification in other industrial groups. Such plants making tires, casings, bodies, hoods, upholstering, asbestos brake linings, etc., are not mentioned in this review but are covered by other reports issued by the Bureau.
