THE AUPONOBILE PAITIS AND SUPPLIES INDUSTHY IN CATADA, 1928.
Production from the automobile parts and supplies industry in Canada during: 1928 was valued at $\ddagger 17,007,157$, according to a bulletin issued by tho Dominion Bureau of Statistics at Ottawa. This was the highest value reported for the industry since the record of $22,000,640$ was established in 1923 . This year's output value was $\$ 2$ millions over the piovious year, "3 millions greator than in 1926 and $\$ 6$ millions more than in 1925.

Only concerns ongagea clifolly in making auto parts or supplios have boon includod in this industry. Of the 77 plants thus classified, 45 wero located in Ontario, 13 in British Columbia, 7 in Manitoba, 6 in Qucboc, 5 in Alberta and 1 in Saskotohowan. Cepital employed in theso factorios totalled $16,343,956$; omployoes numborod 3,509 and thoir carnings wero $\$ 4,756,409$; purchasod matorials cost $, 8,358,404$, and tho valuo added by manufacturing procosses was $8,648,753$.

Articles made in this industry included bodies, springs, wheels, axles, radiators, bumpers, covers, lamps, lubricating systems, rims, tops and curtains, tools, shock absorbers, motor temperature indicators, tire gauges, etc.

The group reviewed in this bulletin includes only those plents in Canade which mamufacture parts or accessories of iron or steel as their principal product. Many other establid ments produce comodities for use in tho alitomobile trade but thoir main businoss is of such a nature as to necessitate their classification in othor industrial ̧roups. Such plmts as make tires, casings, batterics, upholstoring, asbustos brako linings, ote, aro not included in this survay but aro covorod by othor roports issucd by the Buzcau.
